**FINAL ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF SCOTT MILLER AND JAMES V. GRIFFIN
III FOR AN AWARD OF ATTORNEYS' FEES, COSTS AND REPRESENTATIVE
PAYMENTS**

This matter coming before the Bankruptcy Court² on the Motion Of Scott Miller And James V. Griffin III For An Award Of Attorneys' Fees, Costs And Representative Payments (“*Motion*”); the Bankruptcy Court having entered its Final Order Approving and Authorizing Stipulation Resolving (1) Class Claim of Scott Miller and James E. Griffin (Claim No. 177) [and other claims] [Docket No. 1329]; no objections having been received to the Motion; and good and sufficient cause having been shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Court finds that the work performed and hours expended by Class Counsel and by the Class Representatives as detailed in the Motion and accompanying declarations were reasonably appropriate and necessary to the prosecution of the claims on behalf of the Class; that the hourly rates charged were reasonable and commensurate with market rates charged by others with similar skills and



experience; that the costs incurred by Class Counsel were reasonably and necessarily incurred; and that that the requested fee award and incentive awards to all class representatives are appropriate in light of the work performed and results obtained.

3. The following amounts shall be paid out of the first \$3,000,000.00 of the Class Distributions:

- a. To Class Counsel: \$1,500,000.00 in fees, plus \$232,281.85 in expenses, for a total of \$1,732,281.85.
- b. To Scott Miller: \$75,000.00.
- c. To James E Griffin III: \$2,500.00.
- d. To Taylor Sanchez: \$1,000.00.
- e. To Carlos Munoz: \$1,000.00.
- f. To Vanessa Floerke: \$1,000.00.
- g. To Jill Aguilera: \$1,000.00.
- h. To Nell Baker: \$1,000.00.
